

Data Protection & Privacy

The following information informs you of your rights and our usage policy in respect to the information that we may hold on you and lets you know both what we do with it, and also what you can reasonably demand of us in the handling of your business related information. A1 Capital Limited is registered and fully complies with all aspects of the Data Protection Act 1998.

Data Protection

A1 Capital Limited ("A1") collects personal and non-personal information from clients via face to face meetings, telephone discussions, email and written correspondence. A1 is committed to protecting the privacy of its users and have created this Privacy Statement in order to describe and explain to users our information collection practice. How Does A1 Use My Information?

Personal information is collected and used primarily for such purposes as, for example, facilitating information on-line or assessing a potential client.

We may also use a user's email address, phone number or business address to obtain feedback or further information relating to a user's request to us; or to notify a user of new products or services that we think may be of interest; or on other aspects of our business that impact you as a A1 customer.

If a user prefers not to receive email or other forms of communication unrelated to A1 requests for services, the user may opt-out from receiving such communication. The opt-out procedure is discussed in detail below.

We do not sell, rent, share, or otherwise dispose of the personal information collected on [**www.a1capital.co.uk**](http://www.a1capital.co.uk) to any third party or other commercial agencies. We will however supply information gathered from this web site for the submission of loan and financing applications. In such cases clients will be advised of the parties involved prior to those applications being made.

We may, however, disclose your personal information when required by law or in the good-faith belief that such disclosure is necessary to comply with law.

How Can I Opt-Out?

We provide a user with the opportunity to opt-out from receiving updates on any new A1 generated communications. The opt-out option may be exercised by the user simply by sending an email with 'opt-out' to in the header or subject line to [**mail@a1capital.co.uk**](mailto:mail@a1capital.co.uk)

You can select not to be contacted in the future if you wish to not receive any information with respect to and our products. You may also ask us to delete your

records. Account deletion will erase all past entries in regards to your interaction history with A1.

Does Our Privacy Policy Apply to Linked Websites?

Our Privacy Statement applies solely to information collection practice on www.a1capital.co.uk. This web site may, from time to time, contain links to other web sites. Please be aware that A1 has no control or influence over the privacy practices of such other sites. We encourage our users to be aware when they leave details on other linked sites and to read the privacy statements of each and every web site that they visit.

Can I Correct/Update the Information Collected About Me?

You have the right to correct or update the personal information collected about you by A1. To correct or update personal information, a user should write or email the company using the contact details contained in the site.

If we later change our Privacy Statement, we will post those changes on our homepage so our users are always aware of what information we collect, how we use it, and under what circumstances, if any, we disclose it. If at any point we decide to use personal information in a manner different from that stated at the time it was collected, we will notify users by email. Users will have a choice as to whether or not we use their information in this different manner.
